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	<p>PC Hodgetts spoken to. Client is a male adult, 42 years old. Police attended report of a noisy party/disturbance in a tower block. Police heard a disturbance inside number 18. Client opened door and there was a distressed female, Susan Collins present. Signs of a disturbance in the premises and client arrested to prevent a further breach of the peace. No disposal known, officers speaking with female party.</p> <p>Client spoken to, advised of advisor status + that advice is free/independent/confidential, advised client of circs as given by police.</p> <p>Presents as coherent and sober.</p> <p>Client states that the flat is his. The female only stays with him but has her own flat on other side of Birmingham. She has a foot injury and is not very mobile at this time. Both parties have Mental Health issues and neither are taking their meds. Client believes this has caused the argument. Female assaulted him with her walking stick. Client previously under MH section in July 07 and feels in need of help.</p> <p>Advised client of the definition of the matter (harm done or potential harm to person/property OR person in fear because of disturbance OR behaviour provoking violence in public or private), advised police power to arrest to prevent this continuing or happening in the future, advised not a criminal matter, advised of disposal options of release with NFA or appearance at next available court. advised sergeant will decide which one. Also inform client he will be seen by Dr and if he wishes to do so he may ask for MH help. Client prefers to speak to own GP. Inf him reps to be made for release. Call back to advise on outcome.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Address is his. Female has own address. 2. Lack of meds has made situation worse 3. Client more in need of medical help than court. <p>Client does NOT want full MH issue discussed with police or Dr. Fears lengthy delay for police station assesment. Prefer to consult own GP.</p> <p>On call back, sgt not in custody for reps. Contact dets left. Call back agreed</p>

 Reps again re alternate address and not domestic related. Noted but decision remains.
 Client spoken to, advised not a criminal matter, advised police have decided to put before next available court to be bound over. Advised of mechanics of bindover at court. Advised will be allowed to make representations; if agreed to be bound over no risk of custodial and not a criminal conviction. Failure or refusal to enter into a recognisance could lead to imprisonment for up to six months or detention until complies the order unless under the age of 18. Advised in case of any subsequent breach no power to impose custodial sentence albeit recognisance may be forfeited. Advised order is appeal able in crown court. advised can speak to court duty sol at no cost but will not be entitled to get free representations unless in risk of going to prison , advised of continuing right to advice at any time whilst in police custody.
