

## Draft Impact Assessment Market Stability Measures: A Consultation Paper

### Impact Table

The table below shows the impact of implementing the 28th November snapshot data method rather than maintaining the current system in the period 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2007.

The table shows that overall, 44% of providers would experience no change by reverting to the 28th November snapshot.

A total of 86% of providers would experience either no change or a minimal change (reduction or increase of up to 4 slots) over the three-month period. The remaining 14% of suppliers will experience an increase or decrease of greater than 5 slots over the 3-month period.

The total number of firms represents those that are members of police station rota schemes nationally. Police Station panel (and backup) and Court duty schemes are not affected by this consultation.
