

**Invitation to tender to deliver Publicly Funded Housing Possession Court Duty Schemes in England**

**NOTICE TO APPLICANT ORGANISATIONS**

**CHANGE TO THE INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS (IFA) FOR PUBLICLY FUNDED HOUSING POSSESSION COURT DUTY SCHEMES**

On 14 June 2010 we published on our website the IFA for those interested in responding to our Invitations to Tender (ITTs) to deliver publicly funded Housing Possession Court Duty Schemes.

In accordance with our power under paragraph 11.22 of the Terms and Conditions of Tender in the IFA, Applicant Organisations are notified of amendments as follows:

- 1) To correct an error in Annex A on page 45 of the IFA; and
- 2) To correct errors in paragraph references in section 11 of the IFA
- 3) To correct errors in a paragraph reference in section 6 of the IFA

- 1) The second section of the table on page 45 has been amended and now reads:

- 2) Three paragraph references in section 11 (Terms and Conditions of Tender) have been amended. The relevant sections are 11.22, 11.23 and 11.25.

- 3) One paragraph reference in section 6 (About Housing Possession Court Duty Schemes) has been amended. The relevant section is 6.16.
