

# Distribution of Case Costs- controlled work done by NfP Agencies 2005-06

## Note on Data

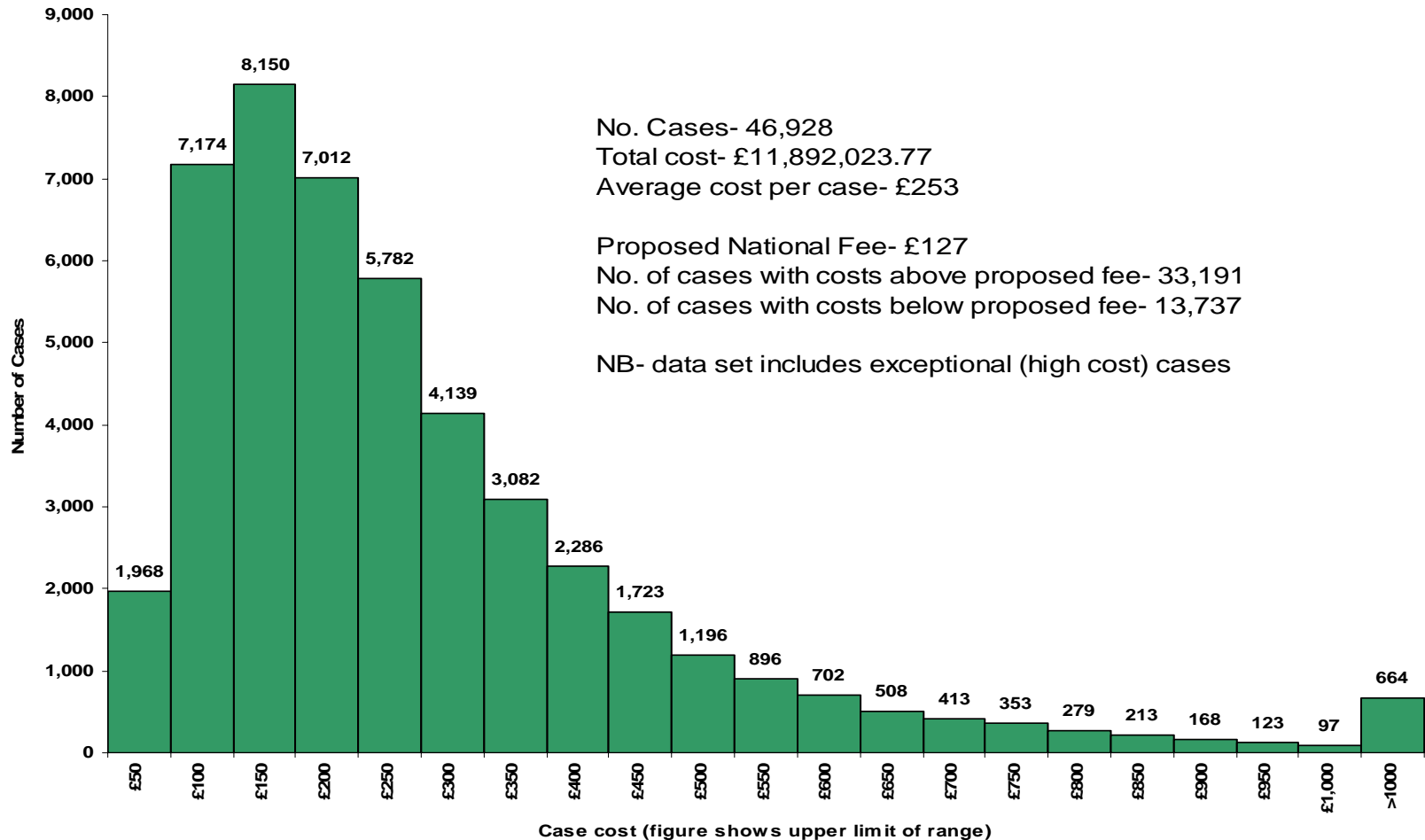
The following slides give distribution charts for case costs in controlled work done by NfP agencies in 2005-06. Since NfP agencies are not paid in the same way as solicitors, their average case costs are calculated differently. For NfPs they have been calculated using the contract value in this category (taking into account Level 1 work) divided by the number of hours allocated to the agency (taking into account Level 1 work), to give an hourly rate. This has then been multiplied by the hours of work actually carried out to give total cost of all cases, which has been divided by number of cases to give average cost per case.

All figures here are exclusive of VAT and disbursements. They include those cases which under the proposed fee scheme would be paid as exceptional cases. This means that the average costs are higher than if (as is the case under the proposed fee schemes) exceptional cases are excluded.

The dataset used is that of cases reported as completed in 2005-06, excluding those whose errors in reporting meaning that calculations with them were impossible.

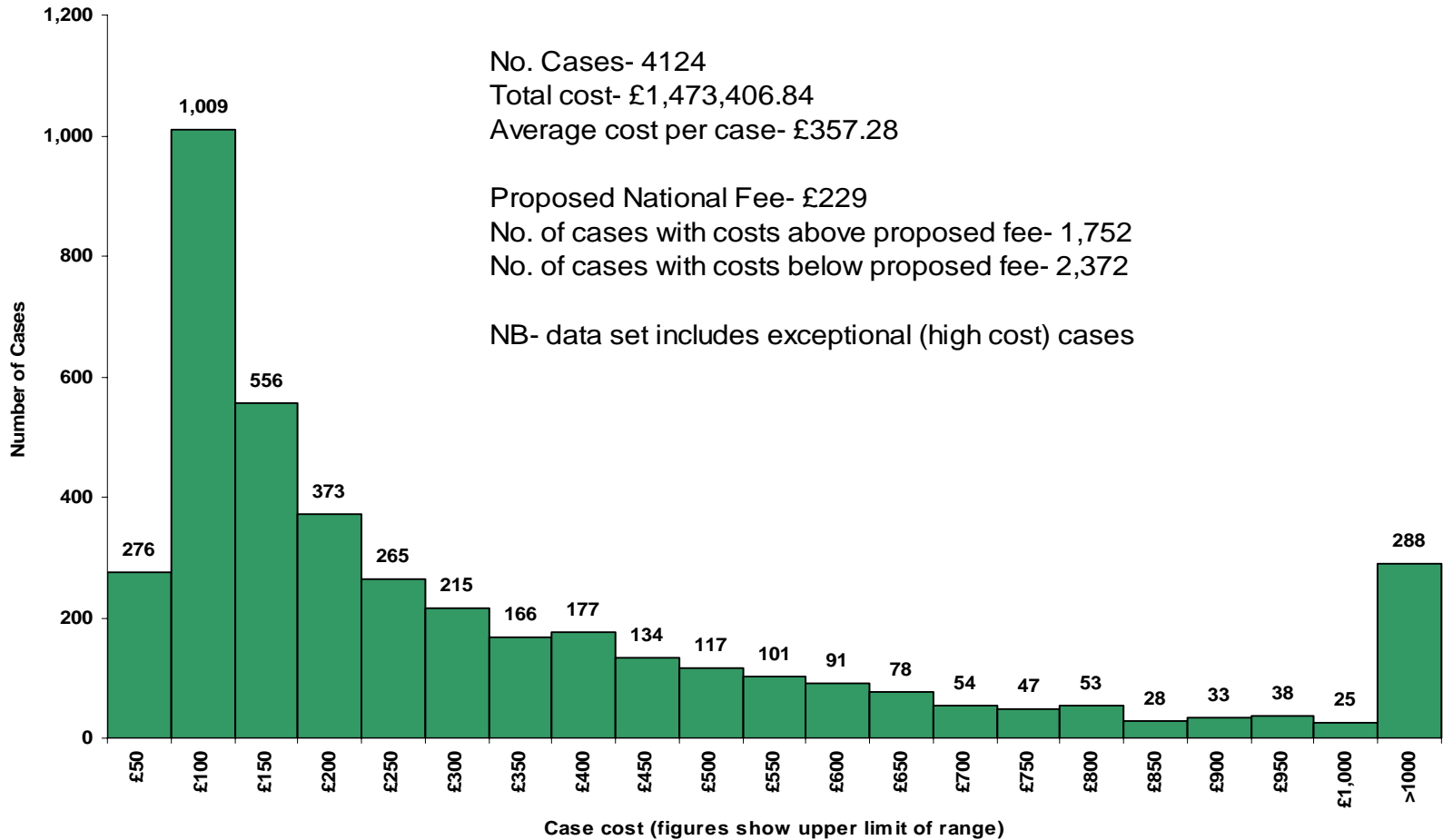
# Distribution of Case Costs

## NfP Debt Cases 2005-06



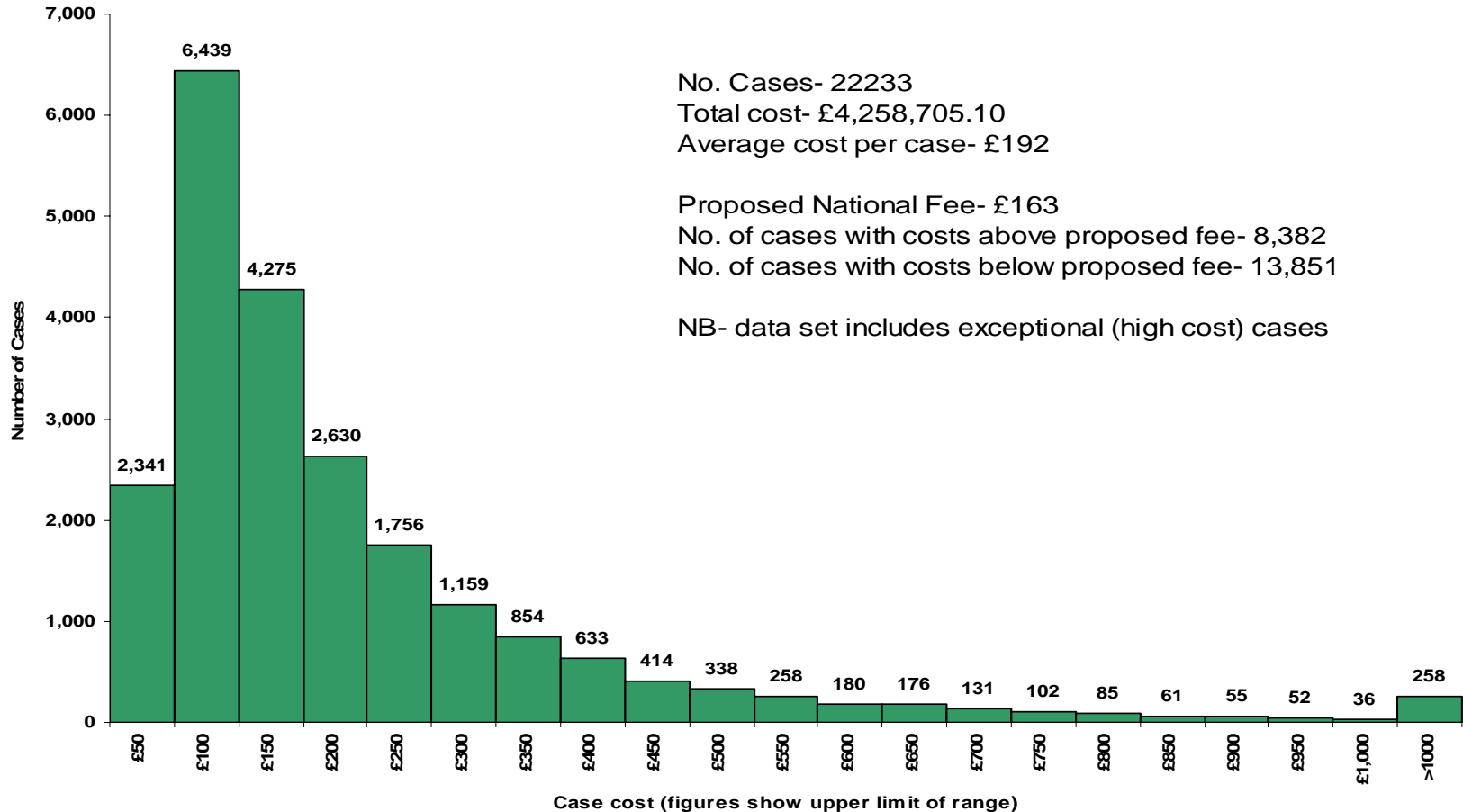
# Distribution of Case Costs

## NfP Employment Cases 2005-06



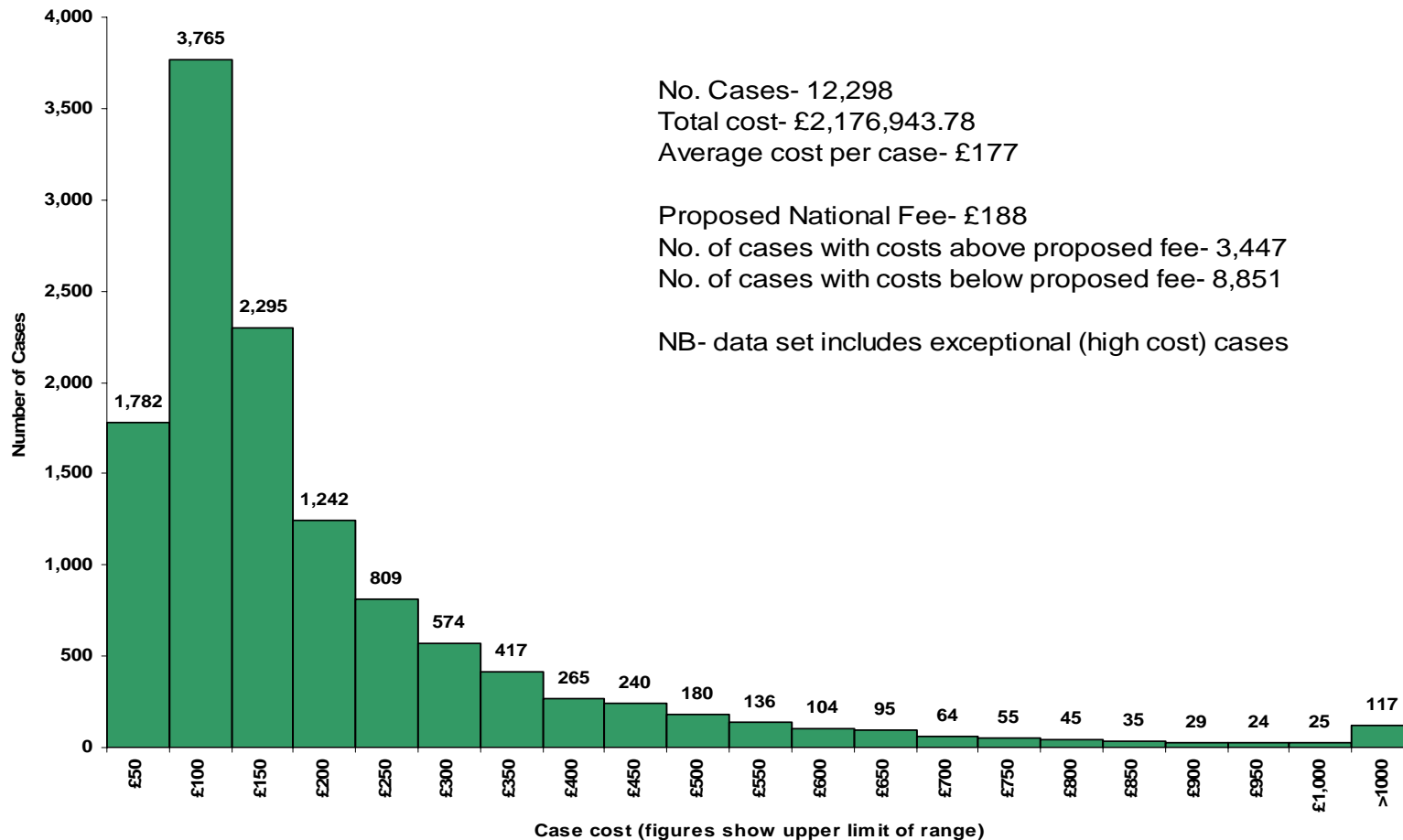
