

## Corrections to Schedule of Duty Solicitor Scheme Rules

### Birmingham Regional Office

To join any other Birmingham Regional Office scheme as an additional scheme will require your office to be "readily accessible" to the magistrates' court covered by the scheme.

1. The rules for Camberwell Green have been clarified to reflect the different eligibility for additional schemes for those firms whose offices are located in the Borough of Southwark and those who are located in the Borough of Lambeth.

They are as follows:

Providers based in Southwark can join this scheme and Bishopsgate, Tower Bridge, Bromley and Greenwich /Woolwich

Providers based in Lambeth can join this scheme and Central London, Bishopsgate, South London, Tower Bridge, Croyden and Wimbledon

2. The rules for Clerkenwell / Hampstead have been amended as follows:
  - a) remove Camberwell Green and South London,
  - b) include Haringey and Highbury Corner.
